

HOW A BILL BECOMES A LAW

For a bill to become law in Idaho, it must follow these steps:

INTRODUCTION

Proposed legislation is introduced and referred to a committee.



COMMITTEE

The committee holds a hearing in which testimony takes place.

Contact committee members

COMMITTEE VOTE

The committee votes to pass, amend, or hold the bill.



CHAMBER FLOOR

The passed bill is sent to the floor for debate and another vote.

Contact your legislator(s)

SECOND CHAMBER

The bill is sent to the second chamber and begins the process again.



GOVERNOR ACTION

After passing both chambers, the governor may sign or veto the bill.
