- Ensuring the maintenance of all district equipment.

- Organize and carry out the annual chip seal campaign.
- Advise the elected board on employee matters, grant applications, equipment purchases, budgets, and road and sign maintenance.
- Attend and participate in local transportation committee meetings.
- Coordinate equipment sharing and cooperation with neighboring highway districts.
- Ensure that the Highway District is compliant with all employment laws, state and federal license and permit laws, and environmental laws.
- Implement the directives of the elected board and its legal counsel.

The successful applicant will possess a Class A CDL with Air Brake and Tanker endorsements, be registered with the FMCSA, have a clean driving record and be able to pass random drug tests as they are called for.
